The Advanced Nurse Practitioners can examine, refer, diagnose, issue MED3s and prescribe and you will be given an appointment with her if deemed suitable. They do not normally see children under the age of 18. Warfarin monitoring is undertaken by the Practice. The Practice Nurses/ANP undertake a Minor Illness Clinic, which can only be booked on the day. You will be expected to tell Care Navigators what the problem is. The Practice Nurses will see things such as Urine Infections, Sore Throats, Coughs, Ear infections, Rashes, Thrush and Emergency Contraception but they will not see long standing problems or see children under the age of 18.

The Practice Nurses also have pre-bookable appointments for things such as pill checks, contraception, injections, and certain holiday vaccinations. They look after the Diabetic Patients and the Respiratory Care (Asthma & COPD) patients, Smear Clinic and Baby Clinic. You can ask at reception for details of the clinics.

The Healthcare Assistants have pre-bookable Blood Clinic Monday - Friday between 8.30am-11am. There are also some afternoon clinics which are primarily for patients on shared care drugs (i.e. methotrexate). Please ring the surgery or call in to book an appointment.

The practice nurses undertake removal of sutures, wound dressings etc. The District Nursing Team have a referral system for the removal of sutures and wound dressing etc, Care Navigators can complete the referral forms. The booking centre will contact you to arrange an appointment. Home visits will be arranged for house bound patients only.

All of the Care Navigators are trained to cover the reception desk and answer the telephones. All Care Navigators book appointments and you will be expected to tell them what the problem is, this information will help to navigate you to the correct healthcare professional. This may be a pharmacist, physiotherapist, dentist, optician, Mental Health Nurse, Well Being Coordinator or the Choose Pharmacy scheme. If you do not wish to disclose the problem, then the practice will still book an appointment, but it cannot be prioritised in

any way. All staff are fully trained/compliant with the need for patient confidentiality. Please be patient and polite with us as we continuously improve the access arrangements for the Practice.

HOME VISITS

Requests for home visits must be made before 11.00am. Home visits will only be agreed for patients who are house bound or where a current condition makes the patients mobility difficult.

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

We DO NOT take request for medication over the telephone. All medication that is prescribed regularly will be on the request slip for a patient to tick and either hand into the surgery or to a chemist where the request will be processed allowing a minimum of 48 hrs notice. You may also wish to send in a stamped addressed envelope for the return of your prescription. Patients can also register with the My NHS App (app.NHS.Wales) and can then order their prescriptions electronically.

REGISTER AS A PATIENT

New patients will need to complete a purple registration form, a health questionnaire, and a Behaviour contract. The practice can then request your medical notes in line with current procedures. This can sometimes take a little while and if you have regular medication, please ensure you will not run out of medication between moving practices wherever possible.

Any new patients who have been prescribed certain medications (eg those that have been prescribed to help with sleep or pain) will be reviewed and will be accessed for a potential reducing program in line with practice policy.

Patients have the right to express a preference for a particular practitioner and wherever possible these needs will be met.
